

What are the costs?

HFP members are required to pay **HPSM** a monthly premium and co-payments at health service locations. The premium amount ranges from **\$4** to **\$42** per child per month, depending on family income. The maximum amount a family will pay for all enrolled children is **\$42**.

Co-pays are made directly to doctors, pharmacies, and hospitals.

- Co-pays range from **\$5** to **\$15** depending on family income
- There are no co-pays for immunizations, check-ups, and other visits for prevention.

Healthy Families

What is the Healthy Families Program?

The **Healthy Families Program (HFP)** is a low-cost comprehensive health coverage program for kids. **HFP** is offered through the State of California in conjunction with participating plans. It provides health, dental, and vision coverage to children without employer paid health insurance and who do not qualify for Medi-Cal. Eligibility depends on your child's age, family size and income, and U.S. citizenship or legal residency.

Healthy Families Program in San Mateo County

In San Mateo County, the **HFP** is administered through the **Health Plan of San Mateo (HPSM)**, a managed-care health maintenance organization (HMO). If you qualify for the **HFP**, **HPSM** will be the health plan that administers your **HFP** benefits. **HPSM** has more than **800** providers, **2,000** specialty care providers, **12+** hospitals, and **234** independent and chain pharmacies to serve you.

Do My Children Qualify for the Healthy Families Program?

The HFP covers children from birth to age 19 who are not eligible for full-scope Medi-Cal. Eligibility depends on your child's age, family size, and income. U.S. citizenship or legal residency is required.
