**Training Completion Required for ACEs Screening Reimbursement Eligibility:
Medi-Cal Providers Must Complete Training for Adverse Childhood Experiences
(ACEs) Aware Screening Services by July 1, 2020 to Receive Payment**

Dear Provider,

Effective July 1, 2020, eligibility for reimbursement for ACEs Aware Screening Services is contingent on the completion of two requirements. To make sure you remain eligible for reimbursement for this service, please complete the two requirements outlined below:

1. Complete the required training here: acesaware.org
2. Self-attest to completing the certified ACE training here: medi-cal.ca.gov/TSTA/TSTAattest.aspx

This is the first-ever statewide effort to screen patients for Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) that lead to trauma and other ACEs-associated health conditions due to stress.
