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Dyadic Care Services

Dear providers,

The Health Plan of San Mateo (HPSM) Medi-Cal Benefit covers dyadic services for children (under the age of 21) and their caregiver(s). Dyadic care refers to serving both caregiver and child together to target family well-being and support healthy development through a model of care intended to address developmental and behavioral health conditions of children as soon as they are identified. It focuses on access to preventive care for children, immunization completion, coordination of care, child social-emotional health and safety, developmentally appropriate parenting, and maternal mental health.
