

Emergency Equipment Requirements

Airway Management and Anaphylactic Reaction Management

Airway Management Required Equipment (In sizes appropriate for population served):

Oxygen Tanks – Wall oxygen delivery system or portable oxygen tank. Portable oxygen tanks are maintained at least $\frac{3}{4}$ full.

Oxygen tubing – kept in close proximity to the tank.

Nasal cannula or mask – kept in close proximity to the tank.

Oropharyngeal airways

Ambu bag and masks

Anaphylactic Reaction Management Requirements:

Epinephrine 1:1000 (injectable)

Benadryl 25 mg (oral) OR 50 mg/mL (injectable)

Safety syringes / needles

Alcohol wipes

Medication Dosage Chart (not the medication insert sheet)

***REMEMBER! Keep documentation of daily, weekly, or monthly checks for expiration and operating status of the emergency equipment.**
